RE: PENNANT PLAYERS - NDBA PENNANT SUMMARY FORM

The Match Committee has decided to use the enclosed NDBA Pennant Summary Form to check all Pennant Players eligibility for the 2010 Season and players gradings during the season.

You should complete a form for Saturday Pennants and a form for Mid-Week Pennants. The Forms should be returned to Association Headquarters by **Friday, 19th February, 2010.**

* **N.B.: ALL PLAYERS SURNAMES & GIVEN NAMES ARE TO BE LISTED IN ALPHABETICAL ORDER, INCLUDING SPARE PLAYERS. DO NOT LIST PLAYERS IN SEPARATE GRADES.**

OTHER POINTS TO NOTE:

- a) NICK NAMES ARE NOT TO BE USED ON RESULT SHEETS –
e.g. Bob Jones is **ROBERT** Jones
Bill Smith is **WILLIAM** Smith

PLEASE ENSURE THAT THE PLAYERS NEW RNSWBA REGISTRATION NUMBER IS USED.

- b) Any additional players used during the Pennant Season should be notified to Association Headquarters. The RNSWBA registration number can be written on the result sheet or on a club letterhead.
- c) Clarification of 2009 Pennant Gradings for 2010 Pennant Players.

Each club is to appoint a CLUB CONTACT PERSON to deal with the Match Committee on issues relating to Players Pennant Gradings.

* **N.B.: Before returning the completed sheets to the Association the Club Contact Person is to make contact with the Association Office or Chairman of Match Committee to check that the gradings being submitted are correct in relation to the Association's Pennant Records. This will ensure a saving of time for both the Club and the Match Committee.**
