ELIGIBILITY FOR SATURDAY POST SECTIONAL GAMES (RULE 16): -

To be eligible for post sectional play a player must have played a minimum of Fifty per cent (50%) of all sectional matches in any grade and be eligible for the grade to be contested.

This requirement may be waived, with the approval of the District and Zone and endorsement of the State Match Committee. Any player for who approval is sought shall be a registered member of that Club.

Where a Club has more than one side in the same grade and the higher of those sides wins a section, players from the other side may act as replacements, subject to eligibility AND with the approval of the relevant Controlling Body. Refer to 4.3.
