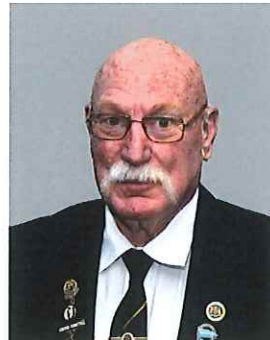

NEWCASTLE DISTRICT BOWLING ASSOCIATION (ZONE 2) INC.
FOR THE YEAR ENDED 30th JUNE, 2019*

CLUB MEMBERSHIP:

This year saw the closing of the Morisset Hospital Bowling Club giving us 46 affiliated clubs within the Association. As at 31st March, 2019 (end of the NDBA financial year) there were 4687 Members in 2018.

EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE:

2018-2019 saw John Smith re-elected as the President of the Association. Vice-Presidents, Terry Blow, Kevin Bucklee, Brian Carling & Danny Rowe retained their positions while David Gilday replaced Keith Rearden and John Bilby replaced Michael Beesley. Don Wells was re-elected to the position of Treasurer.

Brian Carling was re-elected unopposed as the State Councillor for Zone 2. The Chairmen of the Permanent Sub-Committees were as follows, viz Advisory, Brian Carling; Coaching, Ted Masson; Greens, Dave Carroll; Juniors, Jason Stokes (2018) Ross Gardner (2019); Match, David Gilday; Selection, Terry Blow and Umpires, Kevin Bucklee.

The members of the Executive have maintained a busy schedule throughout the year attending functions and presentations at Zone 2 Clubs and other Association events. We thank the members of Sub-Committees who were able to assist when multiple commitments at Pennant Finals and Christmas functions were required.

ADVISORY COMMITTEE:

This has been a relative quiet year for the Committee with a reduction in the number of members and the fact that all of our Advisory Committee Pamphlets and the NDBA Constitution have been updated. The Constitution amendments put forward for the 2018 Annual General Meeting were duly passed.

The Committee was saddened by the passing of former member Charlie Glass (Beresfield) and extends its sympathy to the family and notes the contribution that Charlie made to our work.

The duties of the Advisory Committee are listed in the "NDBA Regulations". COACHING COMMITTEE:

A successful Club Coaching Course was held at Raymond Terrace Bowling Club on the 13th and 14th August, 2018, with 16 applicants (including 5 ladies) attending. The course was conducted by David Cameron, Bowls Australia Presenter/Assessor. Congratulations to those who attended and we wish them well in their new role.

A Selection Module was conducted on the 22nd September, 2018 with a small group of bowlers attending. This course was also conducted by David Cameron, Bowls Australia Presenter/Assessor.

I am pleased to report that John Bilby was a very worthy winner of the Coach of The Year Award. John regularly coaches at his club and received his award at the NDBA Presentation Night.

The Committee arranges for the Association Office to forward letters to all Newcastle (Zone 2) coaches due for re-accreditation. We had a good response to these letters with many coaches due for re-accreditation in 2018 being re-accredited. This year letters have been forwarded to 21 coaches due for re-accreditation and we hope the majority will decide to re-accredit.

Each month the Committee approves an article presented by John Bilby entitled Coaching Showcase for each edition of "On the Green". We would like to acknowledge the continued assistance of the "On the Green" magazine which provides support for our coaches and bowlers alike.

During the year NDBA Secretary Denis Broad resigned leaving new Secretary Warren Shipley to take his place. I would express to Denis Broad the thanks of the Committee members for his immeasurable guidance and support over many years.

Finally, I would like to express my personal thanks to fellow committeeman and good friend John Bilby for his attendance and much needed support during my fifth year as Chairman.

JUNIOR COMMITTEE:

In beginning my first Annual NDBA Junior Committee Report, I think it would be remiss of me not to acknowledge the time, effort and expertise given by our outgoing Chairman, Jason Stokes. Our Juniors and Under 25 representatives have once again had a stellar year through hard work, dedication and hours of training. This year's annual report will proudly acknowledge the achievements of individuals and teams throughout the 2018/19 season. Our juniors and Under 25 representatives have performed exceptionally well and have been recognized both at Zone and State level. Kate Matthews (Raymond Terrace) continues her selection duties for NSW Open and Under 25s teams, as does Connor Freeman (Raymond Terrace) for the NSW Boys Junior Side. Congratulations this year are also extended to our newest recruit and talent, Jake Reid (Raymond Terrace) who was selected to play his first series for NSW Boys Junior Side.

At the State Championships, Zac Nicholls and Connor Freeman (Raymond Terrace) were narrowly defeated in the Junior State Pairs semi-Final.

The NSW State Seven-a-Side held at West Dubbo saw us end third in the overall. The Fours team of Blair Soars, Brendan Stokes, Caleb McDermott and Connor Freeman (Raymond Terrace) won Gold in the Individual events.

September 2018 saw the U25 Challenge take place at Raymond Terrace Bowling Club. There were six (6) sides that took part in the series, Zone 2 had a Junior and Under 25 side, whilst Zones 5, 6, 13 and 15 made up the six (6), each side having 6 players, with 3 disciplines, being singles, pairs and triples. Congratulations are extended to Zone 2 U25 outfit who went through undefeated to claim the shield. The team consisted of Shaun Richards, Lachlan Freeman and Haydn Bojkowski (Raymond Terrace) whilst the Wangi trio of Brae Dare, Jarred Fiddes and Nick Cowburn rounded out the six.

October 2018 proved to be a significant month, for both Junior and Under 25 players alike. Connor Freeman's determination and achievements throughout the year were deservedly rewarded by his selection in the Boys Junior NSW Representative Side to play in the Australian Sides Championship at Capalaba Bowling Club in Queensland and also in the Junior City vs Country series at Cabramatta Bowling Club, alongside Zone 2 Juniors, Zac Nicholls, Zoe Nicholls, Caleb McDermott and Jake Reid. Following the series Connor Freeman, Zac Nicholls, Zoe Nicholls and Jake Reid (Raymond Terrace) were selected in the NSW Gold Tier Squad, and Caleb McDermott (Marks Point) was selected in the NSW Silver Tier Squad.

Wangi Bowling Club and Zone 2 U25 representatives, Brae Dare and Jarred Fiddes also showed that they were a force to be reckoned with, when Brae took out the Zone 2 Rookie Singles Championship, then going one step further and winning the Zone 2 Rookie Pairs Championship with club team mate Jarred Fiddes. But the Wangi boys showed they weren't finished yet, and in November took out the State Rookie Pairs in commanding style. Brae was narrowly defeated in the State Rookie Singles semi-finals, topping off a rewarding period for the pair.

December 2018 saw the Zone 2 Presentation Night take place. After a stellar year, two of our Zone 2 representatives were rewarded for their outstanding achievements. Connor Freeman (Raymond Terrace) was awarded Junior Bowler of the Year, and Brae Dare (Wangi) received the Encouragement Award.

Congratulations are extended to Hunter Academy of Sport who took out the Brett Duprez Development Series at Taren Point Bowling Club in April 2019. The side consisted of Juniors Zac Nicholls, Zoe Nicholls and Blair Soars (Raymond Terrace), Caleb McDermott (Charlestown) and Chloe Appleby (Kurri Kurri), and U25 representatives Kate Matthews and Lachlan Freeman (Raymond Terrace) and Michael Bressington (Charlestown). A special word of acknowledgement is also extended to their Mentor and Coach, Jason Stokes.





1 Accounting Policies

The financial statements are special purpose financial statements prepared in order to satisfy the financial requirements of the Associations Incorporation Act (NSW). The Committee has determined that the Association is not a reporting entity.

The financial statements have been prepared in accordance with the requirements of the Associations Incorporation Act (NSW) and the following Australian Accounting Standards:

AASB 108 Accounting Policies, Changes in Accounting Estimates and Errors
AASB 110 Events after the Reporting Period

The financial statements have been prepared on an accrual basis and are based on historic costs and do not take into account changing money values, or except where specifically stated, current valuations of non-current assets.

The following is a summary of the material accounting policies adopted by the Association in the preparation of the financial statements. The accounting policies have been consistently applied, unless otherwise stated.

(a) Income tax

The Association is exempt from income tax under Division 50 of the Income Tax Assessment Act 1997.

(b) Property, plant and equipment

Each class of property, plant, and equipment is carried at cost or fair value less, where applicable, any accumulated depreciation.

Property

Buildings are measured on the cost basis and are not depreciated.

Plant and Equipment

Plant and equipment are measured on the cost basis less depreciation and any impairment losses.

Depreciation

The depreciable amount of plant and equipment are depreciated on a straight line basis over their estimated useful lives to the Association commencing from the time the asset is held ready for use.

The depreciation rates used for each class of assets are:
