CONSIDERATION OF THE MANAGEMENT COMMITTEE'S:

(a) <u>ANNUAL REPORT</u> – The President, Mr. Mark Conway, in moving the adoption of the Annual Report mentioned the struggle it had been for clubs and the sport over the past 2 and half years and thanked all who have contributed to keeping the game of Lawn Bowls active over that period. He then called for the Annual report to be adopted which was moved by Neville Berry Cardiff BC and Second by Brian Tredinnick Wangi BC

(b) BALANCE SHEET & AUDITORS REPORT

N. Nancarrow, Cutcher & Neale, NDBA Auditors reported that the NDBA Financial Statements were an unqualified report. The report showed that the Association had total assets of \$302,163 with total liabilities of \$46,396 and net assets of \$255,767. The Association had an operating loss of \$10,350 compared to an operating profit of \$18,196 last year. This was due to a reduction in income due to the loss of events held because of COVID 19. He said overall the Association had strong cash reserves with minimal liabilities.

Treasurer, D. Wells, formally moved the adoption of the Financial Statement, Seconded J Bilby. CARRIED

<u>APPOINTMENT OF AUDITOR</u>: Moved D. Wells, Seconded J Wolfe that the firm of Cutcher and Neale be re-appointed as Auditors. CARRIED.
