## Qualification for Saturday and Mid Week post sectional matches

### SATURDAY

#### **14.9. Eligibility for Post Sectional Play (State C.O.P. 3.6.31.)**

To be eligible for post sectional play a player must have been graded in the current season in that Grade or in a lower Grade.

A player who has not been graded in the current season may be approved to play post sectional play by application to the State Match Committee, with the recommendation of the District and Zone.

A waiver of eligibility will only be considered if:

- There are insufficient eligible players available whose current season grading is in the grade required AND
- The Club's next lowest graded side is also involved in Post-Sectional Play.

Applications for players who have not played in the current season will only be considered for the Club's lowest Grade.

### MID-WEEK

#### **Eligibility For Mid-Week Post-Sectional Games:**

In order to be eligible to play in post-sectional matches a player must have played at least four games in the relevant, or lower, grade in the season except with the special permission of the Match Committee.

### NOMINATION

#### **Notification of Teams Selected for Saturday & Mid-Week Post-Sectional Games:**

Clubs participating in Post-Sectional Games should have their team(s) selected with spares by Tuesday 4pm if playing on a Saturday and by the Friday prior to a mid-week game. Clubs to email their nominated team(s) **on the correct form** to the NDBA Match Committee for acceptance.
